


## Tree Protection Plan



## TREE PROTECTION DETAIL

4' MINIMUM ORANGE FENCING AROUND DRIPLINE.  
 6' METAL T POSTS AT 6' INTERVALS.  
 FENCING MUST BE IN PLACE PRIOR TO ANY CLEARING,  
 GRADING OR CONSTRUCTION. TREES WITHIN 15' OF PROJECT  
 BOUNDARY MUST HAVE TREE PROTECTION FENCING.  
 FENCING MUST BE MAINTAINED IN GOOD CONDITION  
 FOR THE DURATION OF THE PROJECT.

### 4' Orange Tree Protection Fence




