

- 100% State & Federal funds

Miscellaneous Drainage Improvements

\$50,000



 Addresses small isolated emergency problems that do not require detailed plans and specifications to correct

Allenby Lake Spillway Repair & Lateral G Mitigation \$150,000



- Project solves two problems
- Repair of the lake's spillway
- Provides Wetlands Mitigation solution as a result of construction activities related to the Lateral G construction project

Wolf River Boulevard Greenway Trail

Connectors

\$1,900,000



- Provides a connector from Nashoba Park to the new trail head
- Provide a connector from Cameron Brown Park to Farmington Blvd.
- 80% state (\$1,520,000), 20% local funds (\$380,000)



Parks Fiscal Year 2018

Farmington Park Playground Renovation

\$306,000



- New playground equipment with input from public and school
- Design will include hardscape, walkways and landscaping
- Site work to improve drainage and control erosion



Parks Fiscal Year 2018

Farmington Park East Field Renovation

\$130,000



- Includes laser grading and irrigation
- Installation of 419 Bermuda for playable surface



Greenway Restroom Replacement

\$175,000



- Numbers of users have increased dramatically resulting in inadequate space and sewer capacity
- Requires constant maintenance and repairs
- Companion Project to Utility Fund Lift Station

\$310,000



- Original roof on the facility that opened in 1996
- Developed many defects including leaks and sheet blisters
- Warranty has expired

Western Gateway Sewer Improvements

Design

\$200,000



- Product of the FY15 Western Gateway Sewer Basin Study
- Analysis and design of new sewer line necessary to accommodate full build-out of the western Gateway District





Land Purchase Southern Avenue

\$350,000



- Properties located at 7598, 7606, 7630, and 7632 Southern
 Avenue became available from New Bethel Church
- Purchase would provide future growth options for Public or a potential new water well field
- Properties were independently appraised at \$350,000





Greenway Restroom Lift Station Replacement

\$60,000



- Numbers of users at the restroom since 2000 have increased dramatically resulting in inadequate sewer capacity
- Requires constant maintenance and repairs
- Companion Project to Parks restroom construction



Utilities Fiscal Year 2018

Southern Ave. Water Treatment Plant Electrical Panel Upgrade

\$183,000

- Design and replacement of original electrical panels of the facility that was constructed in 1978
- Problems began occurring in 2012
- Original parts are no longer available making it nearly impossible to find replacement parts
