Economic and Community Development staff will discuss with the Planning Commission various items for consideration as possible future amendments to the Zoning Regulations, including:

- The provisions regarding landscape preservation areas within the Smart Growth zoning districts;
- The authority of the Planning Commission to vary the number of required parking spaces for commercial and office developments in the C-1, C-2, O, O-51 and O-T districts.
- Situations in which swimming pools may extend up to easements.
- Re-instate in the Smart Growth districts the sign regulations from the original, 2007 version
 of the Smart Code.
- Allow conventional, head-in, angled parking as well as reverse angle parking within Smart Growth districts.
