#### **MEETING CONTENTS**

Bill Pickens state the fiscal year the market value was \$1.265 million up 18.9 % for the quarter and up 9.3 for the calendar year to date. Since the inception the portfolio is down 14.6%. This fund has only been around for a little over a year. The fund was off to a touch start but is recovering well. Ralph Gabb was asked about the cash account. Ralph Gabb stated there was a separate cash account for the fund. The cash account currently had \$49,000.00 but was receiving a check from stop loss in the amount of \$18,000. Should the cash account run out of cash then investments would be sold to supply sufficient cash to meet demands. At the current it was felt that this may not be necessary.
