The annual Friends membership meeting is February 4th at 5 p.m. Friends are considering the possibility of having another sale at the Germantown Athletic Club.

Reports – Germantown Community Library Director

Mr. Page reported on the book drive and upcoming programs. He will be at a library directors training in Florida during the first week of March. Mr. Page and Ms. Nini will participate in a fundraiser for the Germantown Muscular Dystrophy Association.

The Library has been awarded a \$2300 grant from the Tennessee State Library and Archives for a document scanner at the Germantown Regional History and Genealogy Center.

New Business

Dr. Huffman made a motion to accept the FY16 Library Budget Proposal to be considered later in the year by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen. A second was made by Mrs. Efkeman. The motion approved unanimously.

Joe Burns gave a report on the Tennessee Genealogical Society. They have grown to 600 members and will have a world renowned speaker in November.

Stacey Ewell spoke about upcoming grants including The Big Read for which the City of Germantown has an application. There is a new Marketing and Communication Director for the City.
