STAFF'S COMMENTS / DISCUSSIONS REGARDING THE CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS

a. Germantown Plaza Shopping Center – 2005 Exeter Rd – Request Approval of a Project Directory Sign (Case #: 14-476)

BACKGROUND: On March 26, 1976, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen approved Farmington Shopping Center Phase 1. The Board of Mayor and Aldermen approved Contract Number 1149 for an expansion of the shopping center on December 11, 2006. Additional exterior renovations and façade changes were approved by the Design Review Commission in 1999 and 2011. Current project identification ground sign was approved by the DRC in April, 1996. The DRC approved a sign policy for Germantown Plaza Shopping Center on September 28, 1999 and revisions were approved to the policy in 2014.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: The applicant is requesting approval of a new secondary ground-mounted project directory sign at the Farmington Road entrance into the shopping center. This proposed second sign will be smaller than the recently approved sign on Exeter Road. It will also be double-sided and internally illuminated as reflected on the submitted sign details. The specifics of the request are as follows:

SIGN:

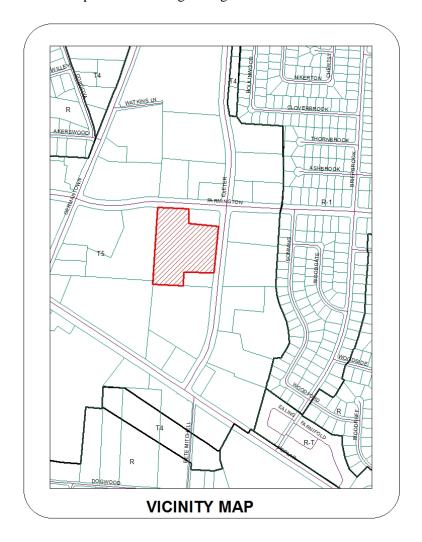
Location & Height:	The sign will be 20 feet behind the curb of Farmington Road, perpendicular to the street, with a maximum height of 6 feet above the ground.
Sign Area:	36 sq. ft. total, per face (19.39 sq. ft. = Tenant Sign Area)
Tenant Sign Panel	2.5 sq. ft. (15"x 24.75")
Content:	BED BATH & Tuesday Morning HOBBY LOBBY

STAFF COMMENTS:

- 1. The total allowable sign area is 36 sq. ft. for a second medium retail project directory sign. The total sign area of this sign conforms to the sign regulations.
- 2. The height of the letters on the individual tenant signs varies from 3" to 4.6". The minimum height requirement is 6" for the primary project directory sign which can be up to a maximum of 120 square feet in size and 10 feet in height. The sign regulations for a secondary sign provides only for the maximum height (6') and total sign area (36 sq. ft.). It is unclear if the same minimum letter height of 6 inches is to be applied to both the primary and secondary signs. It does states that "The height of the letters composing the name of the shopping center shall be larger than the letters of the tenant names" and "All tenant names on the project directory sign shall all be uniform in height". The letter height proposed on the secondary project directory sign is proportional with the size of this smaller sign.
- 3. Staff recommends that the existing shopping center sign policy be updated to allow administrative approval for tenant signs on the project directory sign.

If approved, the applicant must obtain a permit from the Memphis /Shelby County Office of Code Enforcement prior to installing the signs.

c. Robbins Construction – Farmington Centre – 7849 Farmington Blvd. – Request Approval of a Wall-Mounted Tenant Identification Sign

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: On May 28, 1998, the Design Review Commission approved the Farmington Centre Sign Policy. On March 25, 2003, the DRC approved the existing ground-mounted sign for the shopping center.

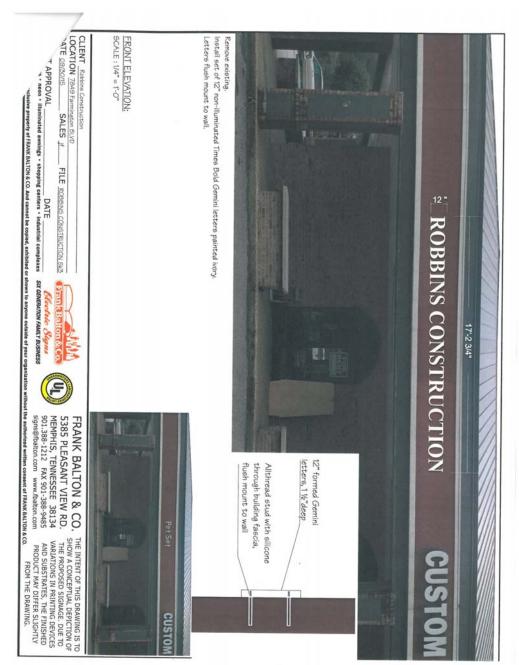
<u>DISCUSSION</u>: The tenant is occupying the space formerly occupied by Pet Set. The sign requires DRC approval because it is to be formed of acrylic letter, where the center's sign policy requires aluminum letters.

STAFF COMMENTS:

1. The center's sign policy calls for all signs to be made of .080 in. aluminum, dark bronze in color and illuminated. The proposed sign is acrylic, with no illumination, and ivory in color. DRC approval is required for signs that do not comply with the sign policy.



<u>PROPOSED MOTION:</u> To approve an acrylic, non-illuminated, ivory colored sign for Robbins Construction Co. at 7849 Farmington Blvd. in Farmington Center, as described in the sign application and subject to staff comments.
