

Germantown Technology Commission Minutes

June 18, 2019

The regular Germantown Technology Commission meeting was held Tuesday, June 18, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the Information Technology Training Room at 1930 S. Germantown Rd., Germantown, TN. 38138

Call to order: Commission Chairman John Colmer called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.
