What is the Germantown Living Legacy? The Germantown Living Legacy is a plan to coordinate landscape design for public areas in the city. The trees planted through this plan will give joy to residents and visitors who pass through Germantown for many years. A Living Legacy can be a gift to honor or to memorialize. It can welcome a newborn child, honor a special teacher, surprise a friend, thank a coach, or a speaker or an officer of a civic organization. It is the perfect "easy to give" gift for Mother's Day, Father's Day, birthday, holiday, or graduation day. It could be a "welcome to Germantown" gift or it could be we're sorry to see you leave Germantown" going away gift.

Living Legacy Trees

A list of tree types includes varieties recommended for this area by a certified arborist. They are considered "long lived" specimens that adapt well to the city environment and will require minimal care to grow and thrive. Some of these have a flowering habit or other seasonal interest such as foliage or colored stems that make them beautiful choices. To request a list contact Parks and Recreation.



How Does the Living Legacy Work? A professional landscape architect has designed a plan for all public land currently in existence for Germantown. As Living Legacy gifts are received, they are combined until sufficient funds are available to purchase and plant the trees - as directed by the City Beautification Commission and Tree Board. To select a tree and the location, the cost is \$150. The person/family will be notified of the gift, and an acknowledgment will be sent to the donor. A plaque with a permanent list of donors and honorees are displayed at the Germantown Municipal Center
