"

#### Notes:

- 1. Staff may request additional information to ensure compliance with local, state and federal regulations.
- 2. A tree removal permit may be required.
- 3. Permits must be obtained from Shelby County for any electrical, plumbing, mechanical and gas installations made as part of the construction by properly licensed subcontractors. Any electrical, plumbing, and drainage improvements must be shown on the site plan.
- 4. Permit Application Policy and process is subject to change without notice.

### **Conditions of Permit Issuance:**

- 1. The finished side of new fencing must face outward from the lot.
- 2. Subdivision covenants and restrictions may also govern fence/wall placement. Covenants/private regulations are not enforced by the City and may be more restrictive than City Ordinances.

3. The Approved Site Plan/Permit is void if incorrect information is given on the application for the permit.

## References

**Setbacks:** Per City of Germantown Code of Ordinances <u>Sec. 23-237</u>, "Swimming pools in the R residential district shall be located behind the front line of the building, a minimum of five feet from all property lines.

On double frontage lots, in-ground swimming pools may extend 20 feet into the required front yard that is located on the rear side of the principal building. This shall apply only to lots having frontages on two non intersecting streets. Corner lots and triple-frontage lots, abutting two streets at their intersection, shall be excluded.

**Sewer Connection:** All Pools must have a connection to the sanitary sewer and pools must be drained into the sewer system, not onto the ground or into the storm drains.

Floodplain and Floodway Restrictions.

\*NOTE: Once approved, the site plan shall not change. If a revision to the site plan is required, the applicant must notify the City of Germantown and reapply for the permit.
