CONSIDERATION OF June 15, 2010 MINUTES

A motion was made by Margaret Owens, seconded by Hillery Efkehan, to approve the minutes of June 15, 2010 as distributed. Motion unanimously approved.

LIBRARY DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Melody Pittman stated that June 2010 had been the largest circulation month ever for the library at 40,083 books.

Other highlights of Ms. Pittman's report:

- She also reported that on July 7th Memphis Light, Gas and Water gave away 250 energy kits in about an hour at the library.
- On Sunday, July 18th, more than 100 people attended the Cypress Creek Concert, a bluegrass band that performed in front of the windows in the Germantown Community Library.
- She spoke about Mango languages database which would be available soon and stated it was going to be a great asset for people to be able to use at the library and/or online through their library cards by remote access.
- She reminded everyone about the special needs pool party at the Germantown Athletic Club at 7:45 p.m. on July 23rd and acknowledged the Germantown Woman's Club for giving a grant for that event.
- She also reminded everyone to be present for the July 26th Board of Mayor and Aldermen meeting at City Hall when the library would present a report.
