Operation Lifesaver - A public education program to end collisions, deaths and injuries at places where roadways cross train tracks, and on railroad rights-of-way.

Identity Theft and Fraud Prevention - Anti-fraud training and education. Presentations would be tailored for a specific group (Business, Senior Citizens, etc)

Personal Protection - This would cover aspects of protecting oneself against different types of crime. I would also discuss how not only to protect yourself against criminals, but to also know what you can/can't do to protect yourself. This includes criminal and civil issues.

Interviewing and Background Checks - This would include interviewing techniques for prospective employees, caregivers, babysitters, etc. How to check criminal/civil backgrounds. And how to determine if someone is being deceptive in their answers.

Illegal Drug Detection and Identification - This topic would include how to spot drug use and how to identify illegal narcotics. This could be used by parents, teachers, employers, etc.

Home Security - Making your home unattractive to burglars; basics of home alarm and video systems

Help Is On the Way ...But - is a general presentation about being ready for disasters.

Emergency Assistance for Veterans – An overview of assistance from various Veterans Service Organizations that might be available to men and women who have been honorably discharged from the United States military, and how to apply for that assistance.

Identity Theft – It is estimated that 1 out of 20 Americans will be victimized by identity theft this year. Learn how you can take steps to protect yourself and your family from this pervasive crime.

Personal Safety – The holidays, an evening on the town, a quick trip to the store, everyday errands or spending time at home; one's personal safety is an ever present concern. This presentation shows how you can be vigilant against being a victim of crime.

Senior Scams – Life's Golden Years should be filled with enjoying life, making memories and spending quality time with family and friends. Learn about the ways you and your loved ones can protect yourselves from being targets of ruthless scammers who target this time of a person's life.

Safely Using the Internet - Safely using the internet means more than knowing which sites to avoid. Listen for news that you can use at work and at home.

Safety City - Safety City is a safety education program for five and six year old children. The presentation discusses the activities at Safety City, how and when to enroll children, and how to volunteer to work at Safety City.

Get Involved in Your Community - Our community needs adults and teens who are interested in becoming involved in the community to do volunteer work in Germantown. Examples included are: Safety City week; assisting with Child Car Safety Seat Checks (Saturdays); and CERT class.

Fire Safety in the Home / Home Safety, Myth versus Truth How to protect your home from common fire hazards. (Uses a DVD/TV optional)

CPR Training – Learn how to protect your family and learn life-saving techniques to provide immediate care.
