Subject: Polygraph Examination Applicant

Previous Revisions:

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish procedures for administering pre-employment polygraph examinations to applicants for the Germantown Police Department that are authorized as a precondition of employment.

II. POLICY

It is the policy of the Germantown Police Department to use a pre-employment polygraph examination in the applicant screening process. Such examination(s) will be performed only by a licensed polygraph examiner.

III. PROCEDURE

- A. The officer assigned to conduct background examinations for the Department will provide the requesting applicant with a Waiver and Consent Form. At the time of the polygraph examination, the examinee will be interviewed and provided with the questions to be asked on the examination.
- B. All polygraph examinations conducted by the Department shall be administered by a State of Tennessee licensed examiner. The laws and rules governing polygraph examiners in the State of Tennessee shall be covered in Tenn. Code Ann. 62-27-101 through 62-27-128.
- C. Under no circumstances shall the results of the polygraph examination be the sole determinant of an applicant's employment status. Statements made during pre-test or post-test interviews and information obtained during the background investigation may be sufficient to support decisions relevant to employment status.

IV. <u>REVIEW PROCESS</u>

An annual review of this policy will be conducted to determine if it should be revised, canceled or continued in its present form.

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This order shall remain in effect until revoked or superseded by competent authority.
